

Netted bracelet with crosses

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Materials:

Seed beads in a main colour (here it is turquoise) and seed beads in a contrast colour (here it is yellow AB)

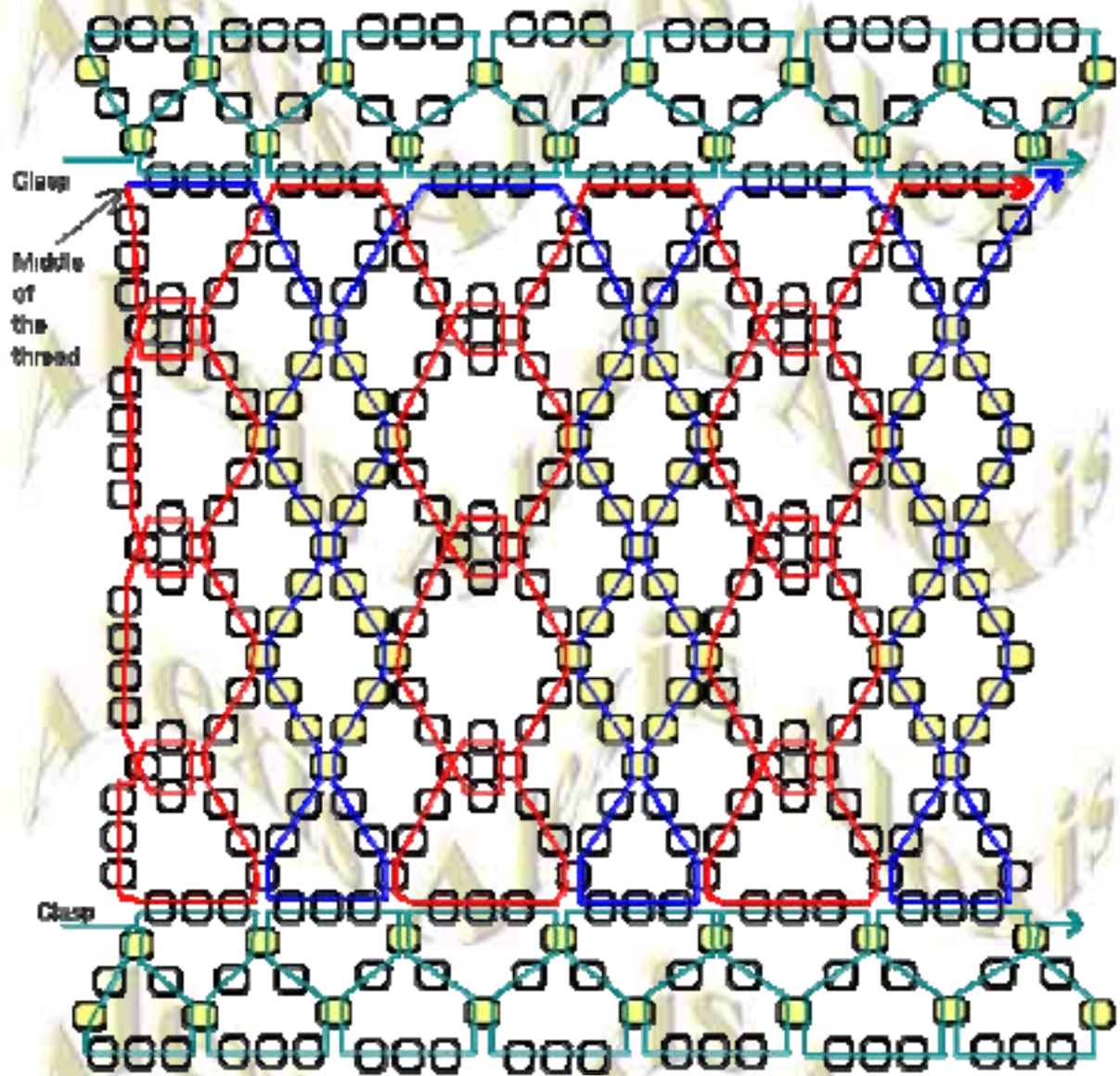
The bracelet is made like the necklace.

This time I made the netted part first and added the chevron chains later. I used one thread with a needle on each end – one end follows the red thread path, the other the blue one. The arrow in the diagram shows the middle of the thread.

Of course you can make the chevron chains first and add the inner part later – that is up to you. You can make the netted part in two steps, too. Just follow the red path to the end, add a new thread and follow the blue path ...

Just one warning if you made the necklace first: the chevron chains have three outside beads on both sides. You don't want the bracelet to curve like the necklace, do you? ☺
