Earrings "Princessa

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





Materials:

- 4 mm facetted beads (8)
- 4 mm round beads (8)
- 000 3 mm round beads (6)
- 0 2 mm round beads (2)
- 0 11/0 seed beads (22)
 - 15/0 seed beads (44)
 - 28 Flowers (2)
- Bead tips (2) Earwires or posts (2) Nylonthread (fishing line) Maybe a sewing needle for enlarging the holes of the waxbeads.


First you make the two flowers, each with 5 11/0 seed beads:





go through the upper 11/0. Go through the facetted bead, the three 15/0. The threads go together up through the bead tip and cross in the 11/0. Make a knot, close the bead tip and attach it to your earwire – the

first earring is done!



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
