

Earrings „Princessa“

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Materials:

○ 4 mm faceted beads (8)

○ 4 mm round beads (8)

○ 3 mm round beads (6)

○ 2 mm round beads (2)

○ 11/0 seed beads (22)

• 15/0 seed beads (44)

□ =  Flowers (2)

 Bead tips (2)






Earwires or posts (2)

Nylonthread (fishing line)

Maybe a sewing needle for enlarging the holes of the waxbeads.

First you make the two flowers, each with 5 11/0 seed beads:



<p>Take one 11/0 to the middle of the thread (), go with both thread ends through the bead tip.</p> <p>Take three 15/0, one faceted bead and four 11/0 on each thread. Go again in the same direction through the first 11/0.</p>	
<p>Take one 4 mm bead on each thread, cross in a faceted bead and go up through the 4 mm beads.</p>	
<p>Cross in a 4 mm bead and go down through the 4 mm beads and cross again in the faceted bead.</p>	
<p>Take one 3 mm bead on each thread and go with both threads through: one 3 mm bead, one 15/0, one 2 mm bead, one faceted bead, one flower, one 4 mm bead. Cross in a 15/0.</p>	

Go up again with both thread up to the 3 mm bead and separate the thread to go through the 3 mm beads at the sides. Take three 15/0, one 11/0 and three 15/0 and go through the outer 11/0 of the little cross, take another 15/0 and go through the upper 11/0.

Go through the faceted bead, the three 15/0. The threads go together up through the bead tip and cross in the 11/0. Make a knot, close the bead tip and attach it to your earwire – the first earring is done!



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
